Sports Premium – Report to Parents – April 2018

The government is providing additional funding to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport has been allocated to primary school headteachers. This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools

Funding for schools has been calculated by reference to the number of primary-aged pupils (between the ages of 5 and 11), as recorded in the annual schools census in January 2017. In the financial year 2017-18 we were allocated £13,112

Principles for expenditure

We have allocated this funding to ensure improvement in the quality of sport and PE provision for all children. We ensure that sport and PE provision addresses the needs of all of our pupils, including those who belong to disadvantaged, vulnerable and gifted groups.

Summary of Sports Premium Spending 2017-2018

- Increased resources for playtime and lunchtime equipment leading to increased activity levels
- Provision of specialist games, dance and gymnastic coaches
- Provision of additional staff to support children in active play at playtimes and lunchtimes
- Provision of lunchtime and after school PE/Sport based clubs
- Provision of Sports Day incorporating newly learnt skills

Outcomes

The children have benefited from expert coaches during their P.E. lessons.

The children have benefitted from increased activity levels.

It is hoped that as funding has allowed more children to access sporting activities it will ignite their interest in sport in future years.

We hope that our work in this area will have a positive impact on the school's commitment to promoting healthy lifestyles.
